

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# UNIVERSAL SPIRITUAL LAW OF LOVE

The primary Universal Spiritual Law, the Law of Love, states that every aspect of the consciousness of God and Creation loves itself and every other aspect of the consciousness of God unconditionally.

In simple terms, the great immutable Universal Primary Law of Love means that all of God, is and ever shall be unconditional love. Unconditional, a love that asks nothing in return, is without human emotion, is without judgement, and is without expectation. It does not ask or expect to be loved in return. It does not judge its own quality or any other quality of love. It has no needs to be met, it is absolute peace and harmony. It exists in and of itself in perfection and as such is a guiding light to all lesser love. Unconditional love is only capable of being unconditional love. In its state of perfection it transmutes all things into unconditional love. Because it expects nothing and judges not, the only thing it is capable of being or doing is love, and creating more love. It has no goal, no ambition, and no desire. Unconditional love exists as immutable, which can never be other than loving and it has no needs, desires, ambitions or expectations.

So important is the Law of Love, that if a person or any life form can act in accordance with it, then it is automatically in accordance with every other Universal Spiritual Law. Love is the true essence of God. At this time in evolution, no human being absolutely understands and operates in the full range of the Law of Love. But it

is possible for one to experience unconditional love without totally understanding what it is or what they are doing.

The human emotions of need, expectations and desires are particularly important when you are working towards gaining unconditional love in interpersonal relationships. It is often easier to unconditionally love a being with whom you have very little actual physical connection. There is no urge to desire or expect, or have ambition where a stranger is concerned. Where the Law of Love is often broken is within families and close friend situations.

As an example: lovers, when they choose to share their life, they always have expectations of the relationship, of things that they will receive together, of what they expect of themselves in the relationship and what they expect of their partner in the relationship. Because these expectations are human in nature they automatically make it very difficult for mates to achieve unconditional love towards one another.

One major expectation in today's human and social relationships is that of fidelity. In general, societies' belief in fidelity demands that in a relationship the two people only love another. One must realize that there is physical or sexual love and spiritual love, which is obviously far more all-encompassing. So individuals do not have to make physical love to feel love for each other. Physical love is only a very small aspect of true or unconditional love. We as humans, love many things including pets, hobbies, wonders' of nature, friends and activities that don't involve physical love or sex. God's Law of Love has no limitations, it is simple. All should love all. It is natural for all to love all, for All is God and God is All.

Additionally, spouses expect from one another, cooperation, understanding, certain duties to be performed by each mate in a mated pair. All of these things are in opposition to the Law of Love.

As humans grow and evolve, they will cease to place limitations upon their abilities to love. The reason for the limitation is fear, and fear is one of the greatest impediments to unconditional love. Humans fear that if they do not make laws, conditions, or agreements that will bind them to one another they will lose the object of their love, and thus they have done so for thousands of centuries upon the earth. They have made laws governing love and most of them not in harmony with God's Law of Love.

Another area in which it is easy to see how the Universal Law of Love is not observed is in parental love for their children, be it blood parents, stepparents, foster parents, and adoptive parents. Most parents unconditionally love the newly born infant, but soon this love becomes adulterated by expectations, by hopes, desires and ambitions for the child. All parents say lovingly, I do not care what my child does as long as he or she is happy, but that in itself places a condition. It is not necessary to want happiness for a child, it is human, and to humans it is natural. If humans understood the Law of Love, they would know that happiness is a natural part of love, and if all were operating within the Law of Love, all would be happy. Therefore, the parent is expressing desire and expectations for the child, when in fact, the parent has no way of helping that expectation become reality, unless they are working within the Universal Law of Love.

Parents believe that they are unselfish in loving if they do not interfere in their child's life, but only wish for the child be happy. It is not necessary for parents to wish happiness for the child, let it decide for itself whether it will be happy or unhappy. In family relationships, in almost every possible way the Universal Law of Love is adulterated in the name of love. It is human possessiveness, not unconditional love, and humanity as a whole is not yet ready to understand these things. The idea that expectations of faithful devotion to duty, is not

according to God's Law of Love, most people on the earth today would not find that they can accept this. They have been taught conditions through many generations to believe that love means expectations, ambitions, the desire to please one another and to surrender to one another. When, indeed love means merging. When two people truly merge their consciousness they seek to avoid the alterations of love. Their sense of absolute oneness enables them to love unconditionally. Few, indeed experience this total merging with other beings. Those who do in society today would probably be considered rather rare or different. Their way of expressing their love for one another would not be as most humans understand it.

Humans are growing and will come to this realization that possessiveness is not love, ambition is not love, expectation is not love, jealousy is not love and fear is not love. As you are learning these things do not attempt to change too rapidly or too radically. Allow others to at least keep up with you in your understanding and expression of love. There would be little profit in saying to your children for instance, that you have no ambitions for them, no expectations for them, that you love them exactly as they are and whatever they do is acceptable to you. In the society that we live in this would not be a practical thing to do at this time. Parental loving guidance can merge and evolve and must in our current society.

While it is important that every individual grow spiritually, individuals must keep in mind they have chosen to be upon the earth plane in a human form. So they must, to some degree, follow the human customs that are necessary to maintain order in society until unconditional love is understood and practiced by all members of society, otherwise children would feel that you did not love them.

These are the hardest things, the most difficult things that stand in the way of understanding and living in accordance with the primary

Law of Love. Divine love is so very different from human love that to most, it is at this point incomprehensible. Many people often talk about unconditional love and many even feel that they express it, but few if any are evolved enough to truly understand unconditional love is our highest goal.

Perhaps the closest examples of unconditional love upon earth today are between humans and other animal species or domestic pets, such as canines, felines and other warm blooded and furry beings. Whatever humans take into their homes and hearts, they seem more capable of giving unconditional love to, rather than to other human beings. This is due in part to the human belief that they are the most intelligent species upon the planet, the only reasoning species, and the only species that understands itself and has self-realization. Humans are incorrect in all of these beliefs of course but they continue to believe them. Because of this, they are capable of loving other life forms that they have taken into their homes without expectation, without ambition and without desire. Therefore, the affection is given, the care is given, the love is given, and if the animal companion in some ways seems to show that it is returning the love, this causes great joy.

On the other hand, some of our animal friends exhibit unconditional love to humans. As an example you can take a dog and put it with the meanest most loathing, as far as human customs goes, rapist, murderer and it would probably do the same things with that person that it would do with a very caring, loving person, assuming the person didn't beat it and abuse it. If the dog bites the owner then supposedly that unconditional love on the part of the human probably will rapidly change to very conditional love, because the supposedly non-intelligent, non-reasoning member of the family, the pet, has exhibited a personality and desired pattern of its own.
